

S.C. Code Ann. § 30-4-80 (Notice of Meetings of Public Bodies):

- Public bodies must provide written public notice of their **regular meetings** at the beginning of each calendar year, including the dates, times, and locations.
- An **agenda** for regular and special meetings must be posted at least **24 hours before the meeting** on a publicly accessible bulletin board and on the body's website, if it maintains one.
- For **called, special, or rescheduled meetings**, notice must include the agenda, date, time, and place of the meeting and be posted as early as practicable, but no later than **24 hours before the meeting**.
- Once an agenda is posted, items generally cannot be added without an additional 24-hour notice, subject to limited emergency or exigent-circumstance exceptions.
- Emergency meetings are exempt from the normal notice requirements.
